














|  | TELEPHONE BOOKS | Keep clean and dry. | No plastic bags. | At sites 1 3 4 7 8 . Call (814) 949-2566 or (814) 6 for additional locations. |
|  | NEWSPAPER Dry newsprint. | Keep clean and dry. Place in paper grocery bags. | No plastic wrappers No plastic bags | At these drop-off sites. 1 3 4 6 7 8 |
|  | MAGAZINES & CATALOGS | Place magazines in paper bag. Keep separate from other paper. | No unwanted mail or other paper. No plastic wrappers. | At these drop-off sites. 1 3 7 8 |
|  | CORRUGATED CARDBOARD | Flatten to save space. | No chipboard, cereal boxes, other cardboard. | At these drop-off sites. 1 3 4 6 7 8 |
|  | HIGH GRADE PAPER White computer and office paper. | Keep clean and dry. | No colored, carbon, wax paper. | At these drop-off sites. 1 3 4 7 8 |

|  | FOOD & BEVERAGE CANS Aluminum and steel cans, food and beverage containers. Empty, dry paint cans. | Empty and rinse. May be flattened. | No pesticide or herbicide spray cans, spray paint cans, aerosol cans, foil. | Aluminum cans at these drop-off sites. 1 2 3 4 6 7 8 Steel cans at 1 2 3 4 6 7 |
|  | GLASS BOTTLES Clear, green and brown glass food and beverage bottles and jars. | Empty and rinse. Remove metal and plastic rings and lids. DO NOT break. Separate by color. | No pyrex, window glass, light bulbs, ceramics, crystal, mirrors, dishes, drinking glasses, milk glass. | At these drop-off sites. 1 4 7 |
|  | PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS Look for a number #1 or #2 inside the recycling symbol on the bottom or side of plastic bottles. | Empty and rinse. Remove metal and plastic rings and lids. Crush or flatten to save space. | No automobile fluids, pesticide and chemical containers, plastic tubs, or plastics numbered 3 through 7. | At these drop-off sites. 1 3 4 6 7 |

|  | LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, BRUSH | Compost leaves and grass clippings. Leave grass clippings on the lawn when you mow. | No plastic bags. No lumber. No garbage. | Call 941-6675 for details or 696-4620 At these drop-off sites. 1 2 3 8 |
|  | SCRAP METAL Iron, steel, aluminum scrap, such as aluminum siding, car parts. | White goods must have freon removed before they are recyclable; call a refrigeration company for details on freon recycling. | Do not damage refrigerant tubing; do not release freon into the air. | At these drop-off sites. 1 9 Only Appliances without Freon accepted at site 2 3 A fee is charged at 1 3 9 |

|  | TV'S & COMPUTERS | Collect the used oil or antifreeze in a clean, unbreakable container with a tight-fitting cap; DO NOT MIX. | Don't pour used oil or antifreeze on the ground, down a storm sewer, or down any drain. Don't mix used oil with any other liquid. | For Used Motor Oil Recycling Call the recycling hotline at (814) 949-2566 or 696-4620 for information on additional site locations for used motor oil.
